Notice of Race

The “II ANDALUSIAN OLYMPIC WEEK”, VII Carnival Trophy, for all Olympic Classes and for RS:X 8.5 Youth as invited class, will be held in the Bay of Cadiz, Puerto Sherry (Puerto Santa Maria) from 26th February to 4th March 2007, both inclusive,. This Event is organised by the Andalusian Sailing Federation with the sponsorship of the “Consejeria de Turismo y Deportes de la Junta de Andalucía” and the “Instituto para el Fomento del Deporte de la Excm. Diputación Provincial de Cádiz” and is considered a **Grade 2 Event by the ISAF**.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, RRS
- 1.2 The Prescriptions of the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation will not apply.
- 1.3 Appendix P (RRS) will be applied. (Except for the Neil Pryde RSX Class)
- 1.4 *Addendum Q will apply to the last race, called the “medal race” of this regatta. It will be included in the sailing instructions and is available on the ISAF website.*
- 1.5 *Personal buoyancy may be required for the coaches and support personnel at all times while afloat.*
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, the English text will prevail.

2 ENTRIES

2.2 The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept late entries.

2.3 The entry fees are:

The entry fees will be paid in the Race Office when registering.

2.4 The minimum number of boats to constitute a class at the entry deadline is :

LASER RADIAL F – 470 F – 49er	10

2.5 Late entries may be accepted with an additional charge of 50% of the entry fees.

3 REGISTRATION

3.1 Each competitor shall register and sign the registration form in the Race Office before 11:30 on the 27th of February.

3.2 Each competitor shall produce the following documents before the end of the registration period.

- 2007 Federation Licence (For Spanish Sailors)
- Evidence of valid third party insurance with a minimum covert of €300,506
- Payment of the Entry Fees.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 The programme for the Event is:

4.2 A 14 race-opening series is scheduled for each event, except the Star for which 9 opening series races are scheduled. 2 opening series races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

4.3 The last possible warning signal on Sunday 4th is 16:30 h.

5 RACING FORMAT

5.1 The courses and competition format will be as similar as possible to those of the Olympic Regatta and will be decided on guidelines from the ISAF.

5.2 The medal race will be conducted on the last scheduled day of racing for each event, if 6 races have been completed by that day. The top ten placed boats will advance to the medal race. All boats advancing shall be required to compete in the medal race. If the medal race is not completed, medals will be awarded based on the series score

5.3 All the Classes shall sail as one fleet, except the Classes with more than 70 entries (30 for the 49er Class) whom will sail a qualifying series and a final series.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Boats may be measured in any moment during racing for compliance with the class.

6.2 All sails, up to the maximum number allowed by the relevant class rules, shall be stamped by the measurement committee according with the program of the event (N. Race 4.1)

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1 For the Tornado and 49er classes rule 44.2 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty.

7.2 Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

8 PRIZES

8.1 The list of the trophies will be published on the official notice board at the beginning of the Event.

8.2 The “Carnival Trophy” will be awarded to the winner of this Regatta.

9 INSURANCE

9.1 Each participating boat and coach boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 300,506 euros per event or the equivalent.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 All those taking part in the II ANDALUSIAN OLYMPIC WEEK, do so at their own risk and responsibility.

10.2 The Organising Committee, the Committees or any party involved in the organisation of the event disclaims any responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage, injury or

inconvenience that might occur to persons or goods, both ashore and at sea, as a result of taking part in the races covered by this Notice of Race.

10.3 Attention is called to the RRS Fundamental Rule 4 in Part I of the RRS, which states:

“The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone”
