Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2005-2008.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply, and will be stated in full in the Sailing Instructions. Notwithstanding the dispensation granted by Yachting New Zealand, sailboard competitors shall comply with clause 1.
- 1.3 The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20.3 (d).

2.0 Changes to Racing Rules

The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

- 2.1 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

3.0 Changes to Class Rules

4.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 49er, 470, Laser, Laser Radial, Finn, Neil Pryde RSX board, Tornado, 420, 29r and Hobie16 classes that comply with their class rules.
- 4.2 Entry fees are stated in New Zealand Dollars and include Goods and Services Tax (GST). Entries close on 1700hrs on Thursday 25th January 2007.
Late entries, may be accepted at the Organising Authority's discretion until 1700hrs on Thursday 1st February 2007

- 4.4 Measurement is not required, however classes that carry a measurement rating certificate shall submit proof of holding one at registration.
- 4.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.
- 4.5 If by closing date, fewer than four(4) entries have been received in any class, the organising authority reserves the right to either cancel racing or make other arrangements for the class(es) concerned.
- 4.6 All entries when accepted will be displayed on the Sail Auckland website (www.sailauckland.org.nz). This display should be considered as confirmation of entry.

5.0 Schedule of Events

- 5.3 *Briefing:*
Thursday 8th February 2007 at 1800hrs at the Kohimarama Yacht Club. A meal will be provided after the briefing.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 is 1200 hours on Friday 9th February 2007.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website from 1st February 2007 or from the Kohimarama Yacht Club from 1500hrs on 8th February 2007.

7.0 Racing Area

The races will be held on the waters of the Waitemata Harbour, Auckland.

8.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course(s) will be Trapezoidal or Windward/Leeward.

9.0 Scoring

9.1 Olympic Classes:

The Low scoring system as amended by the new Olympic Scoring System will apply.

9.2 4 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series

9.3 No score will be excluded until 6 races have been completed.

9.4 The Laser Radial, 420, 470 and 29r classes will be sailed in classes, with Open and Female sailors being scored separately and independently.

10.0 Alternative Penalties

10.1 For the 49er, 29r, Hobie 16 and Tornado classes rule 44.1 and rule 44.2 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

10.2 Appendix P will apply

11.0 Decisions of the Jury

Decisions of the jury will be final in accordance with rule 70.4.

12.0 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to place getters depending on entries.

13.0 Team Support Boats

13.1 Team support boats will be allowed, however their activities may be restricted.

13.3 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration (clause 5.2 above).

14.0 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
